Outdoor Adventure Trip to Tower Wood
Thursday 18 – Saturday 20 May 2017

We are delighted to inform parents that we have now managed to secure a booking for the above venue this year (previously the centre was fully booked)

We had been considering day trips to Towerwood and then a city break at the end of the year. The costing of this alternative for Year 6 was proving to be in excess of £200 – this did not meet our aim of reducing cost. We have also had a large amount of feedback from both parents and children that they would prefer to continue with our Outdoor education residential for Year 6

Parents Information

Your child will be staying at Tower Wood Outdoor Education Centre, Windermere. LA23 3PL (Telephone: 015395 31519 – emergencies only).

He/she will be participating in outdoor water-based activities such as canoeing (pairs and in teams), kayaking and sailing and land based activities such as Jacobs ladder and rope courses.

Towerwood Centre is owned and maintained by Lancashire County Council. It is staffed by highly qualified instructors and maintained by the Education Authority's officers. Tower Wood is licensed in accordance with the Adventurous Activities Licensing Service (AALS). Licence number: L10037/R0136

There will be a total of 27 pupils in our school group.

The Visit Leader from school is Mrs Karen Price. There will be 3 other adults accompanying the trip (Adult to child ratio maintained at 1:7 for all activities with the addition of Towerwood activity tutors)

- **The group will leave school at 8.30am on Thursday 18 May**
- **The group will return by approximately 3.30pm on Saturday 20 May**
- Transport is by school minibus (St.Pauls and Yealand vehicles)

All final payments should be sent to school prior to the trip.
