Dear Parent/Carer,

Our wonderful PTA have organised an **art competition** that all children in school can get involved in. The idea is simple: your child creates something at home and brings it in to school, it gets displayed in the school hall and on Facebook, and a panel of judges select a winner for KS1 and a winner for KS2.


- The theme for both competitions is: **Autumn**. Children can interpret this however they want and use whatever resources they wish. E.g: a shaded woodland animal, a painted autumn scene, a collaged autumn tree etc.
- The PTA have kindly agreed to provide a prize for each Key Stage, to the value of £10.
- Entry is £1 and this should be paid when your child's artwork is brought to school.
- The closing date for the competition is **Wednesday 21<sup>st</sup> October**. Children should give their completed work to their class teacher with their name written clearly on the front (this is for display purposes)
- Please ensure this is the children's own work: you can obviously offer assistance with materials, but the final piece should be completed by the children.
- Work can be on A3 or A4 paper
- All money raised will go to the PTA. PTA money is used in school for a variety of different things: purchasing equipment, developing learning spaces, providing experiences for children and much more.

We are also holding a mufti day on Friday 23 October. This will be £1 per child with proceeds also going to the PTA. Thank you for your support in these difficult times.
