



Outdoor Adventure Trip to Robinwood Wednesday 7th - Friday 9th July 2021

Dear Parent/Carer,

We are delighted to announce that Year 6 children will be visiting the Robinwood activity centre in July 2021. This is a marvellous opportunity to sample a residential trip before they leave for High School. Please read the information below carefully and let us know if you have any questions.

Your child will be staying at Robinwood Outdoor Education Centre, Barhaugh Hall, Near Alston, Cumbria. CA9 3NJ (01706 814554 – emergencies only).

They will be participating in outdoor adventurous activities such as canoeing (pairs and in teams), climbing, zip wire, team challenges and ropes courses.

This Robinwood Centre is registered and approved by Lancashire County Council. It is staffed by highly qualified instructors. Robinwood is licensed in accordance with the Adventurous Activities Licensing Service (AALS).

There will be a total of 29 pupils in our school group.

The Visit Leader from school is Mrs Liz Sharples. There will be 4 adults accompanying the trip (Adult to child ratio maintained at 1:8 for all activities with the addition of Robinwood activity tutors).

- **The group will leave school at 8.30am on Wednesday 7 July 2021.**
- **The group will return at 4.30pm on Friday 9 July 2021.**
- Transport is by a local coach company, details to follow.
- The full cost per child is **£186** which includes accommodation, meals (a packed lunch will be required for Wednesday 7 July) and all activities.
- A non-refundable deposit of £50 will be required by 31st January 2021 to secure your child's place. Only in exceptional circumstances will any payments above the deposit amount be returned if your child is unable to attend the trip at late notice.
- If you are struggling to make the full payment, please contact Mr Gittins for a conversation about this.
- Payments can be made in instalments via Parent pay, with the full balance being due by 11th June 2021.
- A full kit list will be sent out nearer to the date of the trip: please remember old clothes are best!

A permission slip and full medical form will be sent out in the Spring Term, but to give us an idea of numbers we would be grateful if you could return the slip below before 11th December 2020 to confirm if your child will be attending. If your child is not attending, they will be required to attend school as usual on these dates.
