Two-Year-Old Screening Check

We are always keen to gather as much information as possible about the children who are starting in Pre-school. It would be very helpful if we could please have a copy of the 2year old screening check that the Heath Visitor would have carried out to add to our records.

Forest Schools

Pre-school children will get the opportunity to explore the forest school area each half term. Children will wear a mud suit and wellies, this can be provided by school but you can also send your child's own mud suit and wellies in if you would prefer, which can hang in a bag on their peg. Please ensure any items in the bag are clearly named.



Snack Time

All Pre School children will have the option of fresh fruit and vegetables as part of our daily snack time. The children will wash and prepare the fresh fruit and vegetables with a member of staff.

Milk is provided as part of the cool milk scheme for children under five (Please see school office). Your child may bring a named water bottle to school, which will be returned home each evening. Please ensure that it only contains water and not juices. Water is available in the classroom and we encourage the children to drink water at regular intervals throughout the day.
