
My promise is to plan fun lessons to challenge all children and hopefully they will have lots of laughter and smiles along the way.

Your child will be given a reading book to read daily and this will be accompanied by a communication diary. Books will be changed when needed on a Monday, Wednesday and Friday.


Homework


Contact
