Picture Books

In your child's book bag, you will find a picture book along with your child's communication diary. Please encourage your child to use the picture images to retell the story to you. This encourages story language and builds up story telling skills ready for the next phase of reading books with words in.

P.E. & Forest Schools

Diamond Class children participate in two P.E. lessons per week. For this term these will be on Wednesday afternoons and Friday mornings, so please ensure that your child has a named P.E. kit in school.

Forest School will be on Thursday mornings. Please can you also send in your child's forest school kit to stay in school each half term.

It is important that your child's clothes are clearly labelled as it can sometimes be very confusing when the clothes get mixed up at changing time.



Play time

All reception & Year One children are provided with fresh fruit and vegetables as part of the Healthy Schools Scheme. Tuck is also available at playtime – items such as toast or crumpets are available. (Please send money in a named purse for the week). Milk is provided as part of the cool milk scheme for children under five (Please see school office). Your child may bring a named water bottle to school, which will be returned home each evening. Please ensure that it only contains water and not juices. Water is available in the classroom and we encourage the children to drink water at regular intervals throughout the day.
