Science

This term we will be learning all about light and astronomy. We will be investigating shadows and light sources. After half term, we will begin to start a unit of work about animals.

<u>Art</u>

Term we will be creating digital artwork and taking inspiration from digital artists. We will draw, print and make digital works.

<u>Music</u>

We will be learning from the Dragon Song.

French

In French this term, we will be learning some of our basics like numbers, greetings, likes and dislikes. We will then learn about school, including rooms and subjects.



History

In history, we will be learning about the Roman Empire, where it started and how it impacted on Britain. We will think about the chronology of the period as where it is on a larger timeline. We will discover how people lived and how that is different to today.

Geography

In geography, we will study the North Pole and the South Pole. We will consider the impact of climate change on the polar ice caps.

<u>PSHE</u>

We will be looking at our relationships with family and others in PSHE.

Religious Education

In RE this term, we will be thinking about what it means to be called by God and how this has happened to many different people. We will then focus on light as a symbol at Christmas.

Computing

In computing, we will be learning about efficient searching online and ways to do this safely. We will keep a focus on our online safety throughout all of our computing.

PE/Games

Days: Monday and Thursday. In PE this term we will be covering units of work on gymnastics, dance & invasion games (including basketball and rugby).

<u>English</u>

In English we will be working on a variety of genres of writing. We will focus on our spelling, punctuation and grammar as well as our reading skills. **Maths**

In maths we will be making sure we secure our understanding of place value before moving on to addition and subtraction and multiplication and division.
