Reading

The children will have a book linked to their Accelerated Reader book level but can read other books of interest at home too. Please be aware that it may take a few weeks to get the children used to the AR system but we will support them all the way.

Homework

All homework for English and maths will be set on a Friday and should be completed and returned to school by the following Thursday, or before if you would prefer.

Homework information will be added to our Google Classroom (login details will be the same as last year but look in reading record if you are unsure). Please email me if there are any problems.

Break time

Children can bring a piece of fruit for a snack at break time and a water bottle for drinks throughout the day. Please ensure only water is sent to school in these bottles. Juice is permitted for lunchtime. Tuck can also be ordered and paid for daily.

Generally, there will be maths on Mathletics and spelling from Ed Shed, although some weeks there may be a few additional tasks to look out for.
