A mathematics challenge and phonics will be set on Google Classroom every week.

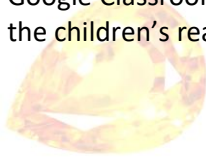
Homework will be set on a Friday and it would be great if it could be returned by the following Thursday.

Tuck Money


