Science

This term, we will be learning all about electricity in the first half-term. We will then go on to find out more about plants.

<u>DT</u>

In DT, we will be tasting, evaluating, designing and making bread.

Art

This term, we will be exploring different types of printing. We will look at mono printing and relief printing.

Music

In music, we will be enjoying improvisation.

French

In French this term, we will be finishing our learning about clothes. Then, we will be learning vocabulary about many different animals and their habitats.





<u>History</u>

In history, we will be learning about the history of the railways. We will look at how technology has changed over time, how the railways changed Britain (for better and worse) and find out about the lives of some key figures.

Geography

In geography, we will be finding out about how land use has changed over time in our local area. We will consider how Caton compares to Morecambe.

PSHE

We will be looking at growing and changing, keeping safe and physical health and wellbeing.

Religious Education

In RE this term, we will be thinking about the rules that we live by. We will link this to the Ten Commandments and rules from other faiths. We will then go on to work on a unit about The Lord's Prayer.

Computing

In computing, we will be learning about coding. We will use some different types of coding software and maybe even try our Microbits!

In PE this term we will be covering units of work on rounders, athletics and net and wall games.

English

In English, we will be working on a variety of genres of writing. We will read and write about the story of The Firework Maker's Daughter and the poem The Spider and the Fly.
