#### Science

This term we will be developing our understanding of life cycles in mammals, butterflies, amphibians and birds. We will also explore Electricity.

## **Religious Education**

**Maths:** We will be focusing on objectives linked to length, perimeter and area, volume, properties of shape, position & direction, as well as consolidating prior learning from throughout the year. **English:** Our English lessons will be focused on a variety of text types and genres myths, poems - figurative language, newspaper reports, mythical stories and debates.
