Prime Areas

Characteristics of Effective Learning and Teaching

Active learning

Children have and develop their own ideas, make links between ideas, and develop strategies for doing things.

Daily Phonics

Letters and Sounds: Year 3-4 Phase 1 – Aspect 1-7 Year 4-5 SAT/PIN
