Science

This term, we will be learning all about electricity in the first half-term. We will then go on to find out more about plants.

DT

In DT, we will be learning about the designer Virgil Abloh and making our own hats!

Art

This term, we will be exploring different types of printing. We will look at mono printing and relief printing.

Music

In music, we will be enjoying improvisation.

French

In French this term, we will be learning the story of Petit Chaperon Rouge (Little Red Riding Hood) and even innovating it to write our own versions in French.



History

In history, we will be learning about the history of our local area and school. We would love to hear from you or other family members, if you came to school at Caton St Paul's as a child.

Geography

In geography, we will be finding out about how land use has changed over time in our local area. We will consider how Caton compares to Morecambe.

PSHE

We will be looking at growing and changing, keeping safe and physical health and wellbeing.

Religious Education

In RE this term, we will be thinking about the rules that we live by. We will link this to the Ten Commandments and rules from other faiths. We will then go on to work on a unit about The Lord's Prayer.

Computing

In computing, we will be learning about coding. We will use some different types of coding software, as well as looking at online safety linked to gaming.

In PE this term we will be covering units of work on rounders, athletics and net and wall games.

English

In English, we will complete our focus on The Iron Man, writing newspaper reports about the events in the story. We will then move on to a variety of genres of writing. We will read and write about the story of The Firework Maker's Daughter and the poem The Spider and the Fly.

Maths

In maths, we will be exploring money, measures, shape, time and statistics. We will also consolidate all of our previous learning from the year.
